

# Take the More Challenging Blackbutt Walk

If you're keen on bushwalking, the 6.4km Blackbutt walking track winds through lush rainforest, offering scenic views of Dorrigo National Park.

Watch the ever-changing landscape along this challenging hike that has a couple of steep climbs that will really get your heart racing.

Winding through lush rainforest, beside and across the Endiandra Creek, it follows the escarpment and offers breathtaking views towards Dorrigo plateau.

Be prepared to take photos, because you'll want to capture images of the beautiful Callicoma Falls and Casuarina Falls, as well

as the many tall, majestic trees, and the view across to the Dorrigo Plateau.

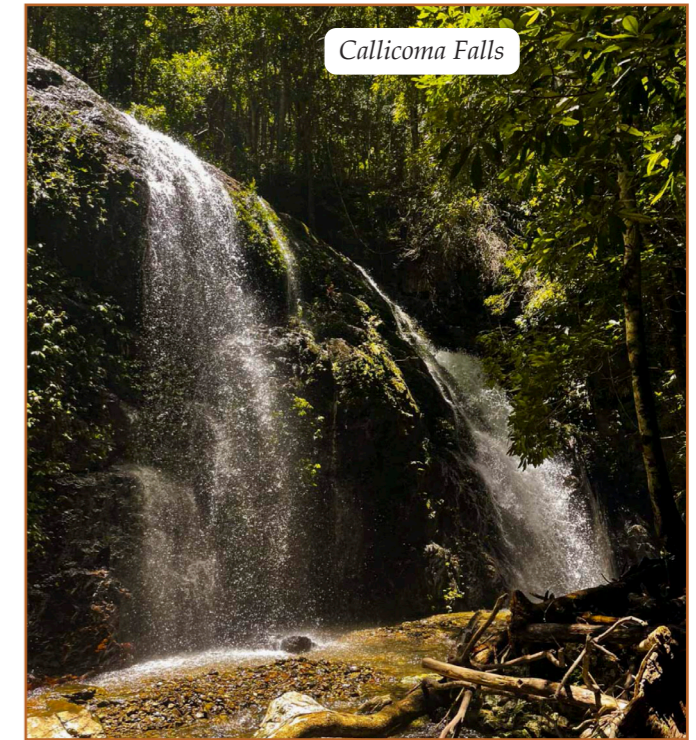
Before or after your walk, enjoy the serenity of Never Never picnic area.

Remember to take your binoculars if you want to go bird watching.

At the end of the walk, either return the same way or take the easier option and follow Dome Road back to the carpark.
